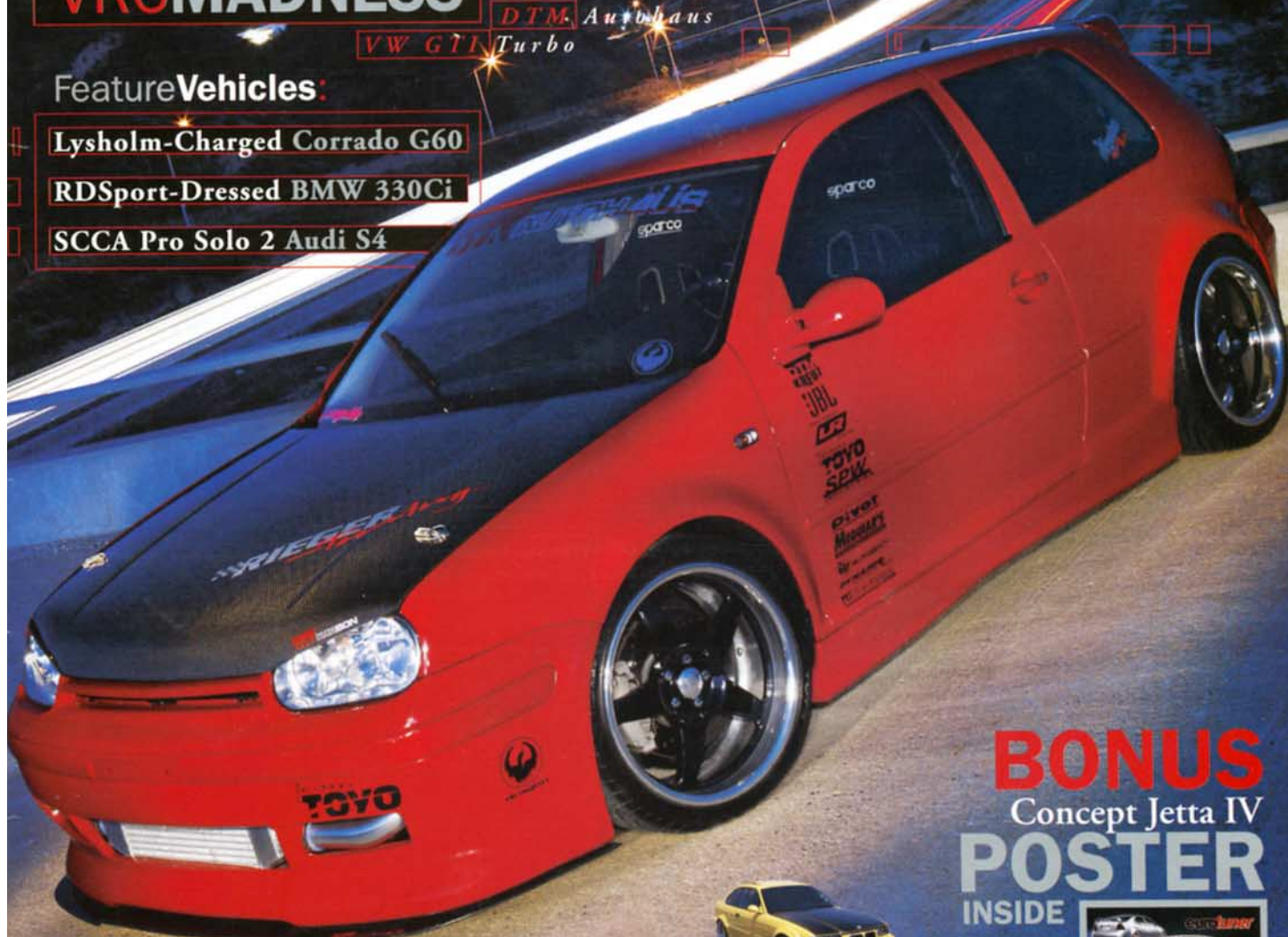


SO-CAL Speed Shop MG ZT-T

▶ **When you think of Bonneville, your mind** usually conjures up images of the infamous Salt Flats and oddly shaped cars hitting speeds they should never be capable of. Back in the late '40s, SO-CAL Speed Shop ran left, right, and center at Bonneville with American musclecars, and now the company is returning with, believe it or not,

an MG. The purpose-built MG ZT-T was created by the speed shop, Roush engineers, Peter Stevens (the designer of the McLaren F1), and Mobil 1 with the goal of running at Bonneville. Initial test runs at El Mirage, a smaller salt flat, found



the little car posting a 181.521mph Fourth gear pass. With that speed, the MG is sure to make it into Bonneville. Check out www.socal-speed.com for more info on the company and the MG. We'll post the car's Bonneville results as soon as we get them.

▶ **Just over a year ago, we reviewed** www.xrims.com and liked what we saw, with one exception—the site was very basic. Utilizing simple Web programming, the site loaded quickly but hardly offered any visual bling to captivate its audience. What it did offer, however, was a place to sell and buy wheels on the Web without having to sift through hundreds of Forum boards in the hopes that someone was selling your bolt pattern in the brand you wanted. Since our review, the site has been completely revamped, and now XRims.com is as interactive as ever. Most importantly, however, the site retains the very endearing quality of being completely free. Simply registering allows you to post your used wheels and tires for sale, and via use of the region locator, potential buyers can find wheels for sale that are located close to home. This feature alone can save you significant money when it comes to shipping charges. When we reviewed the site, it was being launched with its new design, meaning some of the pages had yet to be completed, but from the looks of things, once everything is up and rolling, it's a site that should be frequently visited by anyone who has an obsession with changing his or her wheels each season but doesn't have the cash to buy them new.
